NAPP endorses various comments of Christopher Turoski, submitted Feb. 23, 2021, in response to the USPTO's request for comments on ways of promoting diversity in the corps of IP attorneys and agents who represent inventors.

In particular, NAPP endorses the suggestion that the USPTO support increased visibility and availability of patent agent career paths that avoid the burdensome time and financial commitments of a traditional Juris Doctorate (J.D.) degree program. NAPP further endorses the suggestions to open up the Patent Drafting Competition and the Law School Clinic Certification program to all those persons eligible to pursue a patent agent registration, not just students seeking J.D. degrees.
